Mergers, Acquisitions and Divestitures

Site environmental clean-up costs can often exceed the value of the acquired/divested asset. Newly discovered contamination can delay or halt manufacturing projects due to regulatory hurdles. Providing an environmental review in advance of the transaction can reduce risks and provide an “innocent landowner” defense against remediation costs. {42 U.S.C. 9601(35)(B)}.
